CIVIL RULE 77.4 EX PARTE COMMUNICATION WITH JUDGES

<u>Unless the opposing counsel or party in pro se is present</u>, <u>Aa</u>ttorneys or parties to any action or proceeding should refrain from writing letters to the judge, or otherwise communicating with the judge, <u>concerning the action or proceedingunless opposing counsel is present</u>. All matters to be called to a judge's attention <u>concerning any action or proceeding</u> should be formally submitted as hereinafter provided.
